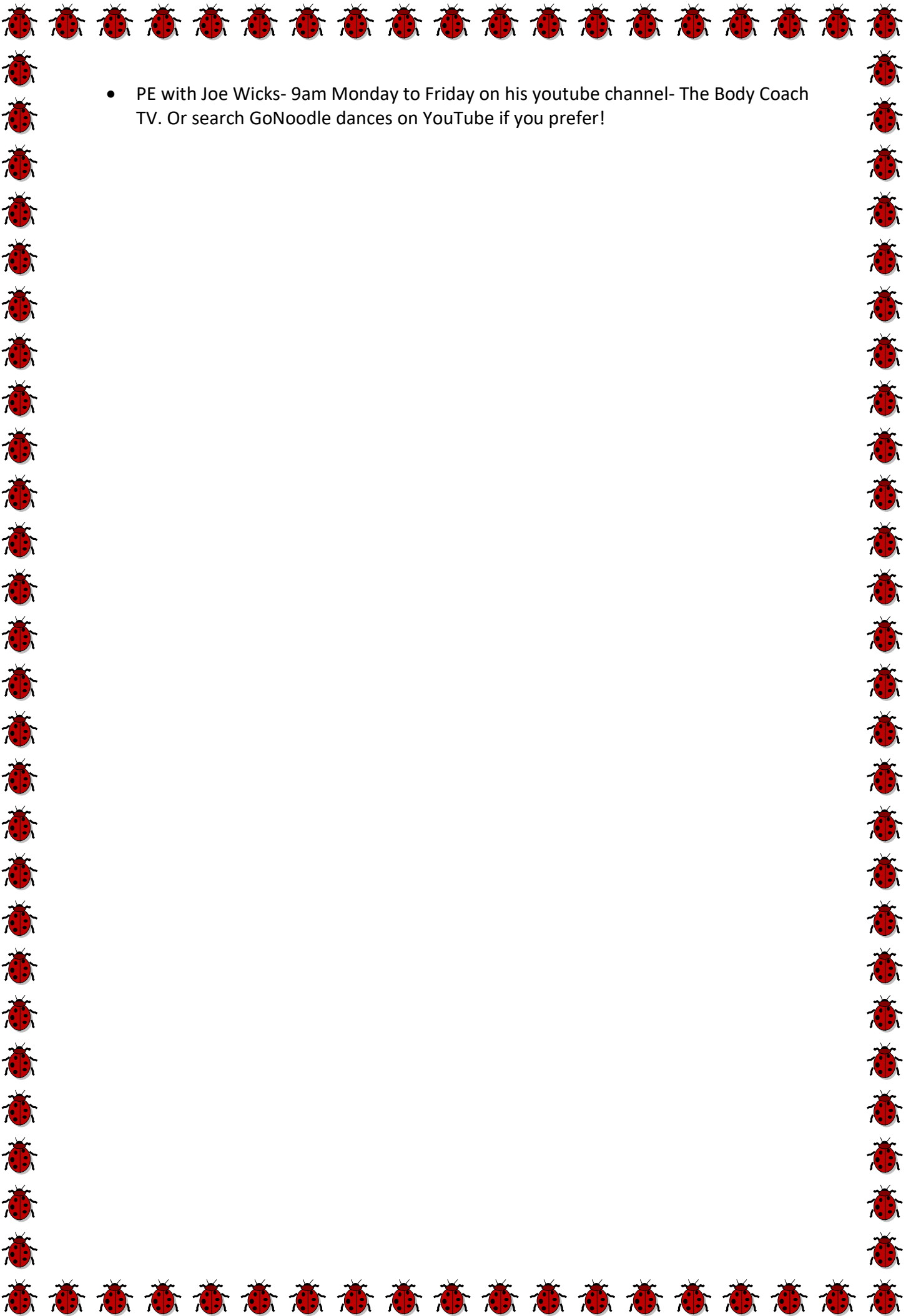
- Play Phonics games on phonicsplay.co.uk (Username: march20 Password: home)

Maths

- Continue using the TT Rockstars program and the Numbots program.
- Use the splat 100 square. <https://www.primarygames.co.uk/pg2/splat/splatsq100.html> Get your grown up to choose two numbers for you e.g. 12, 43 splat these numbers and practise counting from the first number to the last. Repeat this take care when counting onto the next ten number.
- Can you go on a 3D shape hunt in your house? There is a 3D shape hunt sheet you can use or you can draw your own tally to record your results. Mark on the tally chart each time you find a 3D shape. Which 3D shape did you find the most of? There is a 3D shape mat to help you with the names for each shape.
