Phonics - Please keep reading at home and practising your phonics. Remember reading to your child is just as important as listening to them read! Practise your number bonds to 10, use top marks 'hit the button' -

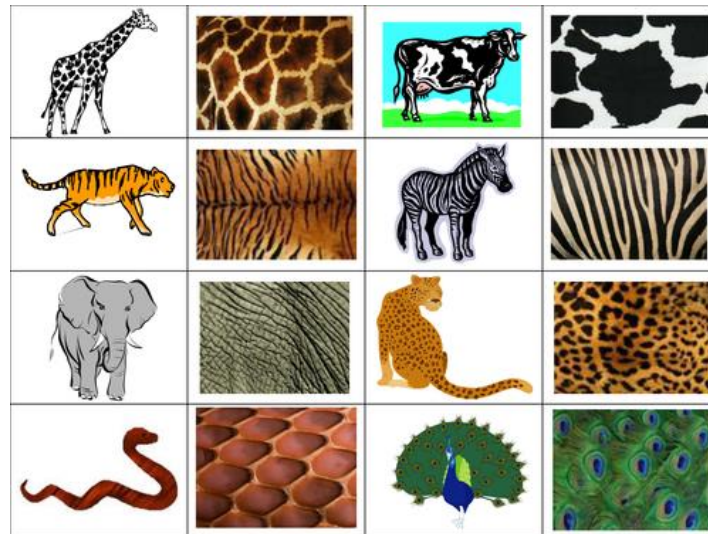

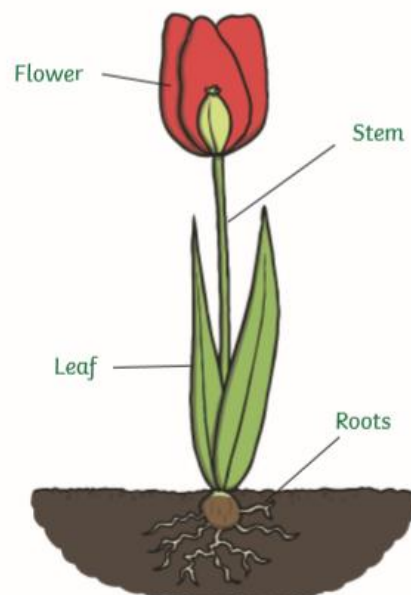
