Ask a grown-up to write a simple sentence, such as 'Look at my cat.' They can then cut the sentence up into individual words. Can you read each word and put the sentence in order?

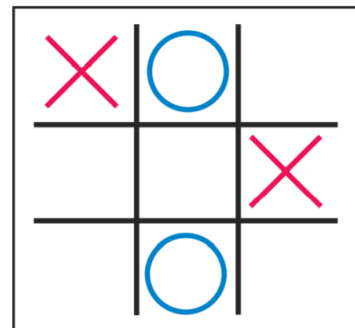
