Nursery have been learning all about Chinese New Year. We have made lanterns, rabbits and dragons. We tasted Chinese food and did some dragon dancing.




RECEPTION






If your child is going to be absent from school please report this to the school office by no later than 9.30a.m. on 01782 234450
