A few things you need to know are:

- You will have your own peg in the cloakroom. Your coat will go on your peg.
- You will have your own tray in the classroom to keep your belongings in. Your book bag will go in your tray.
- You will read at school with a teacher every week in a guided reading group.
- You will take home a 'share with me book' to read with your family and a 'Reading Record' diary. We love to see comments about your reading at home. You get a special reading Dojo point for every time you read at home.
- You can bring water in a named water bottle to school. We keep our bottles in a tray on the side in the classroom.
- Please bring a named P.E. kit in a named bag to school. This will go on your peg.
- We have Busy Bees in Year 1 instead of 'Special day' people. Two children are chosen to be the Busy Bee everyday. They stand at the front of the line for the day and help to do any important jobs.
- Homework goes onto Class Dojo every Tuesday. Homework is to be completed by the following week. You will receive a special dojo point for completing your homework.
- We ask for a voluntary contribution of 50p a week, this helps us to pay for extra treats for super work and behaviour and for other items that enhance our learning for example, baking and planting.
- Keep an eye on Class Dojo the day before you start school in September. There will be a special message from us.

Please remember to label everything that comes into school!

To enter Year 1 you will walk up the veranda ramp on the left hand side to enter the first door.
